### Overview

At Ascent College we aim to support autistic young people into employment and or supported/independent living opportunities. Our careers programme has been designed to meet the needs of all students and provides a wide range of career development opportunities which align to the Gatsby benchmarks. At Ascent College we use the student vocational profiles and EHCP outcomes to help the student to identify their skills and their aspirations to develop a vision for the future. Parental views and involvement is important to us and questionnaires are sent out regularly. Careers education is embedded within the curriculum and students are placed in one of four career groups; Aspire, Develop, Experience or Engage. All career activities and staff/student feedback are evidenced in individual career plans.
